Director's Note

Orchestra students are back up and running after what felt like a very short winter break. East students began our first week back pivoting to their unit on chamber music (WSMA solo & ensemble) and started rehearsing music for All City String Festival.

Speaking of hitting the ground running, on January 8th, Dr. Benjamin Whitcomb, cello and music theory professor from UW-Whitewater joined East orchestra students to talk about music post high school, work with a few student volunteers, and to play some unaccompanied Bach on his cello.

On another note:

Now that we're in the middle of the winter, it's important to remind our students of the best ways to keep instruments safe during the cold season.

- Keep instrument in the case
- Try to avoid extreme temperature changes
- Don't leave instruments in the car
- Try to maintain a consistent humidity level. [Dampit](#) makes an inexpensive humidifier.
- Remove rosin dust after every use
- Keep instrument away from heat vents
- Keep extra strings on hand
- Allow instrument time to "warm up"
