Teacher's Corner

Orchestra students are back up and running after what felt like a very short winter break. East students began our first week back pivoting to their unit on chamber music (WSMA solo & ensemble) and started rehearsing music for All City String Festival.

On another note:

Even though it hasn't been super cold yet, it is always a good idea to be mindful of temperature changes this time of year and how it impacts our string instruments.

Here are some helpful tips.

- Keep instrument in the case
- Try to avoid extreme temperature changes
- Don't leave instruments in the car
- Try to maintain a consistent humidity level.

Dampit makes an inexpensive humidifier.

- Remove rosin dust after every use
- Keep instrument away from heat vents
- Keep extra strings on hand
- Allow instrument time to "warm up"
